- Varieties: Muscat Bailey A 97%, Others 3%

## Tasting Note:

The color is a bright ruby hue.

Aromas of red fruits such as strawberries blend harmoniously with sweet notes reminiscent of cotton candy and vanilla derived from the barrel.

On the palate, soft tannins and moderate fruitiness are complemented by a crisp acidity that brings the flavors together

## Tasting Note:

A radiant yellow

The refreshing scent of grapefruit and the aroma of ripe pineapple are harmoniously balanced.

The gentle acidity blends with the richness derived from well-ripened grapes, creating a wine that is light yet has depth





## Fuefuki Koshu Gris de Gris

- Varieties: 100% Koshu
- Type: White
- Region: Fuefuki
- Alcohol Level: 10.5%

## Tasting Note:

It has a gentle pink-orange hue.

It has a warm aroma of tea and apple pie, as well as hints of quince.

In the mouth, the wine has a pleasant acidity, a slight astringency like black tea, and aromas of yogurt and peach compote.
