

Single Malt Scotch Whisky Glen Scotia Victoriana

Glen Scotia Victoriana is a cask-strength, non-chill-filtered single malt from Campbeltown, Scotland, bottled at a robust 54.2% ABV. It pays tribute to the Victorian era. It features rich notes of roasted sugar, dark berries, and a subtle, smoky finish.

Key Details & Facts

- **Region:** Campbeltown, Scotland.
- **ABV (Alcohol by Volume):** 54.2%.
- **Maturation:** Matured in bourbon casks, then finished in heavily charred oak and Pedro Ximénez (PX) sherry butts.
- **Filtration:** Non-chill-filtered and has no added color.

Tasting Notes

- **Nose:** Smells like toasted brown sugar, vanilla, and caramelised fruits.
- **Taste:** Tastes full-bodied and oily with rich, dark berries, chocolate, and spice.

- **Finish:** Long and smooth, leaving a hint of cocoa and dark fruit.

Why is it unique?

It uses *cask strength*, meaning it is bottled directly from the oak barrel without adding water to dilute it. This preserves the intense, raw flavor of the whisky.
